

| Radiators | All | Burn | Instructions provided | Medium | Do not cover heaters | Low |
| Personal Belongings on Floor | All | Trip and Injury | | High | Make sure area around sleeping area is clear, Keep personal possessions and bags out of the way of where people will be walking. | Low |
| Sleep walkers | See Health Forms | Falling out of bed, exiting the building | | Medium | Make leaders aware. | Low |
| Camp beds | All | Trip and Injury | Instructions provided | Medium | Only use camp beds at night, fold away during the day. Camp beds to be put up under adult supervision (or by adults in the case of under 10s) Consider providing nightlights overnight so that people can see to walk about. | Low |

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| Asbestos | All | There is asbestos under the carpet in the activity room and corridor between kitchen and bathroom. | Regular inspections carried out. The asbestos is not accessible and poses no danger to visitors unless damaged | Low | Don't lift the carpet Report any damage to the floor immediately | Low |
| Dirty Floors | All | Hygiene and damage to possessions | | Medium | Remove shoes /boots in entrance and store in porch | Low |
| Stacked Chairs | All | Chairs falling over and injuring someone | | Medium | Do not store items on top of chairs, do not allow people to sit on stacked chairs. Stack chairs 5 high with chair backs against the wall. | Low |
| Tables | All | Injury from tripping over tables or tables falling and injuring someone | | Medium | Tables to be stored on table trolley when not is use Trolley not to be moved when full | Low |
| Putting Tables up | Adults | Injury/Trapping Fingers | | Medium | Take care lifting the table from folding to upright. Use tool to put tables up or carefully use hands to fold down legs. | Low |
| Trips/Falls | All | Injury | | Medium | Sweep/vacuum /mop floors and warn people if wet. Keep chairs tucked under tables. Make sure mess is kept to a minimum Tidy up activities once they are complete. Do not let wires / leads trail across the floor | Low |

| Cleaning Materials | All | Chemical Burns/Irritant | | Medium | Do not store cleaning materials in cupboard in bathroom unless locked. Store out of children's reach | Low |
| Hot Water | All | Scald/Burn | Sign to inform people how to use | Medium | Make sure thermostat is set to correct temperature | Low |

| The Dark | All | Not being able to see and tripping over | Outside lights provided | Low | Bring a torch if you are arriving, leaving or plan to be walking around outside in the dark Low |
| Mobile phone reception poor | Mobile Phone Users | No reception | | Low | Step outside building for better coverage. Low |
| Car Park | Car users | Injury to people/damage to vehicles | | Low | Park sensibly taking into account ground and weather conditions Low |
| Ice and/or snow on lane | Car users | Not being able to get out of the site | Grit bit at the end of Corks Lane | Medium | Clear lane with shovel (can be found in barn 4) Don't attempt to drive cars until completely clear. |
| Dogs | All | Dog causing distress or injury | None allowed on site other than assistance dogs and the volunteer warden Any dogs must be on a lead | Medium | Clean up any dog waste immediately. Low |
| Security | All | Intruders | The site is on private land with clear signage | Low | Consider adding security controls in your own risk assessment Low |
| Uneven pathways | All | Slips/Trips/Falls | Regular maintenance of the site | Medium | Use torch at night Walk carefully wearing sensible footwear |
